This letter should be submitted as part of the application packet.

- 3. What is one activity or lesson that you would like to implement in Homeroom next year? How would you improve Homeroom for the freshmen (Getting rid of Homeroom is not an appropriate response)?
- 4. Is there anything else that you would like us to know about you?
